Grape Varieties: Aragonês, Alicante Bouschet, Trincadeira combined with Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah

Alcohol: 14% Vol.

Wine making: Each grape variety is made separately, respecting its optimal period of maturing to produce the intended style.

Ageing: Not aged in wooden casks.

Tasting Notes: Aromas of red fruit such as ripe black cherries. In the palate, full upfront fruit characters of plum and blackberry and a mouth filling wine with soft fine tannins and a lingering finish.

Serving suggestions: Cheese and meet dishes.

Serving temperature: 16-18°C
